New Business

- FSAE unveiling party (April 27): request for donation of event entries to raffle off as part of their fundraising efforts
 - Might bring in new people
 - 5x entries (including waiving the SCCA weekend membership). Ed motions, Dave seconds; passes unanimously.
- Street Survival
 - Teresa & Erica McKee to run the event
 - Location might move, as Crows is out of the way
 - Possible location: Las Positas College, in Livermore
 - o Parking lots can be rented. Discounts given for non-profits
 - Lots might not be large enough. Reminder: this isn't for an autocross.
 - 3x adjacent lots might be workable all together
 - Classrooms are rented; access to classrooms includes access to restrooms.
 - The location might be ideal.
 - Total estimated to be \$1850 for 3x lots, 2 classrooms for 5h, restrooms, and custodial services
 - o Do we have a projector?
 - Not with the trailer.
 - Glen can lend one.
 - Does the college have one in the classroom?
 - From a budget standpoint:
 - \$1000 grant from various sponsors
 - Insurance covered by SCCA/TireRack
 - Estimated budget = \$2800; might be tight considering breakfast, lunch, water, snacks must be included
 - If a region is upping the ante from previous events, SCCA would throw in an extra \$500 to the total offered on budget. Could go up to \$1000 if Street Survival registrations for this season exceed expectations.
 - Cost is acceptable if we come near to breaking even. Better to have registrants than to restrict the school.
 - Other than food, water, supplies, what else would we need?
 - Gas for the tow vehicles and the generators.
 - Trailer transport?
 - Not Troy. Maybe Ed?
 - Date might change, depending on Las Positas' schedule
 - Teresa asked about dates after June
 - Las Positas is working out their Fall schedule; will get back to Teresa in April
 - We will keep the Crows weekend booked for now, to leave our options open.
 - Instructors:
 - Can't just pull people who haven't taught before

- Street Survival offers a course online to learn what is being taught
- Rob Luis?
- Maybe ask experienced instructors in BMWCCA
- AAS was told by the security people that they don't cover Crows Landing anymore. If we have trouble at the Pro, call CHP instead of the security company.
- Tech might be better if it's not done on grid. Suggestion is to have a tech station instead.
- No Stockton news.
